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See Your Lake House Through a Designer's Eyes

Most lake houses weren't originally designed for the way families use them today.

Over the years, rooms evolve one purchase at a time—new furniture is added, accessories accumulate, and spaces begin serving multiple purposes. Before long, the home still functions, but it no longer feels intentional.

The goal of this guide isn't to encourage a complete renovation. It's to help you recognize the opportunities that already exist within your home.

By stepping back and evaluating each space through a designer's perspective, you'll begin to identify what supports the way you want to live—and what quietly works against it.

Throughout this guide, ask yourself:

- Does this room feel welcoming the moment I walk in?
- Is the furniture arranged for conversation and connection?
- Can guests move comfortably through the space?
- Does the room support both everyday living and entertaining?
- Would someone visiting for the first time immediately know how to use the space?
- Does this room feel calm, collected, and effortless—or simply full?

The 5 Principals of a Great Lake House

Beautiful lake homes aren't created by following trends. They're created by designing spaces that support the way people gather, relax, entertain, and make memories together. As you move through this assessment, evaluate each room using these five principles.

Function Before Furniture

Every room should make daily life easier.
Furniture should support conversation, movement, relaxation, and entertaining—not simply fill empty space.
Ask yourself:
"Does this room work as beautifully as it looks?"

Comfortable Gathering

The best lake homes naturally bring people together.
Whether it's morning coffee, card games, family dinners, or evenings on the porch, every space should invite connection.
Ask yourself:
"Would people naturally want to stay here?"

Visual Simplicity

Luxury rarely feels crowded.
A thoughtfully edited room feels calmer, larger, and more intentional than one filled with too many pieces.
Ask yourself:
"Could this room benefit from doing less?"

Indoor Outdoor Connection

One of the greatest features of lake living is the relationship between the home and the water. Your interiors should naturally encourage movement outdoors while bringing the beauty of the lake inside.
Ask yourself:
"Does this room celebrate where we are?"

Designed for Every Generation

The most memorable lake homes welcome everyone and makes every generation feel comfortable. Children, Teenagers, Friends, Grandparents and Weekend guests
Ask yourself:
"Can everyone enjoy this space with ease?"

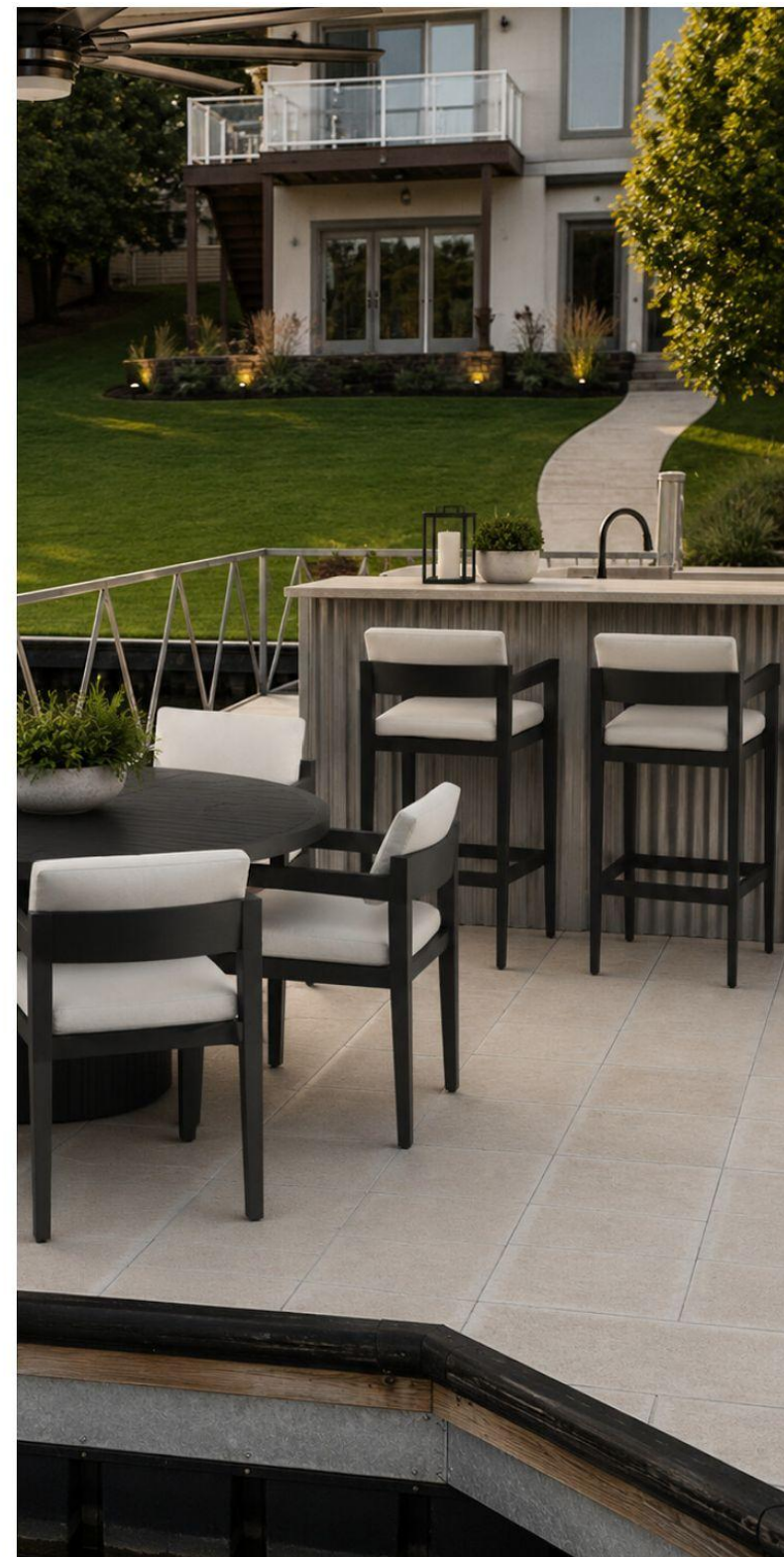
